

PUBLIC NOTICE  
Discharge Permit Application  
Northern NM Wood Business Park, DP-1726

DP-1726, Northern NM Wood Business Park, Les Montoya, San Miguel County Manager, proposes to discharge up to 6,000 gallons per day of domestic wastewater to a treatment and disposal system. Potential contaminants from this type of discharge include nitrogen compounds. The facility is located at 179 NM State Hwy 250, Las Vegas, in Section 6, T16N, R17E, San Miguel County. Ground water beneath the site is at a depth of approximately 55 feet and has a total dissolved solids concentration of approximately 360 milligrams per liter.

The applicant is seeking a Discharge Permit for the proposed discharge. Provided the applicant has met applicable requirements, the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) will propose a Discharge Permit containing limitations, monitoring requirements, and other conditions intended to protect ground water quality for present and potential future use. Information in the public notice was provided by the applicant and will be verified by the New Mexico Environment Department during the permit review process. NMED will accept comments and statements of interest regarding the application and will create a facility specific mailing list for persons who wish to receive future notices.
